## Begin the registration process

You will need to take the computerized two-hour Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) to determine your correct course level. Once your assessments are completed and evaluated, you can register for a class near you.

## Jump Start Scholarship

Eligible ELA and HSE/GED® program completers may qualify for the \$500 Jump Start Scholarship, which provides tuition assistance to help you begin your studies at COD.
