Writing, Reading, Speech Assistance (WRSA) has developed a variety of **interactive modules**, or workshops, available On Campus and via Zoom, to support the goals and course objectives of instructors across all areas of study at College of DuPage. These modules are designed to:

- Focus on discrete aspects of writing, reading, and public speaking.
- Be interactive by asking students to participate in guided work.
- Be adaptable to specific course materials.
- Support the daily activities instructors and students engage in.
- Align with specific course objectives and broader learning outcomes.
- Be adaptable to courses for non-native speakers.
- Be 50-75 minutes long depending on the workshop/instructor's needs.

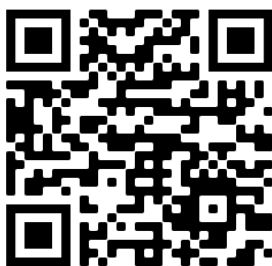
When Instructors request a mini module, we ask them to:

1. Fill out our Google Form for either **On Campus** or **Zoom** (two weeks in advance if possible).
2. Provide a first and second choice of days.
3. Write a brief description of their goals.
4. Be present for the workshop.

When Instructors request a mini module, we will:

- Be in contact within 36 hours.
- Send a confirmation email once times, days, and coach assignments are decided.
- Discuss goals and particulars if necessary.
