# 3+1 CHECKLIST

Do you want to earn a bachelor's degree without the high cost of a four-year university? Consider one of College of DuPage's 3+1 programs.

COD has collaborated with prominent local universities to offer bachelor's degree programs at a reduced cost and with a seamless pathway. Take three years of classes at College of DuPage and one year with a partner institution. The additional fourth year courses are taught by a faculty member at a partner university, typically on COD's campus. You earn your bachelor's degree from the partner university.

- Step 1:** Apply to College of DuPage.
- Step 2:** Discover if there is a 3+1 program for your desired major. Check [cod.edu/3plus1](http://cod.edu/3plus1) for a complete list of our available 3+1 partnerships.

**Currently, we have 3+1 programs with:**

- Benedictine University in Management and Nursing
- Concordia University Chicago in Healthcare Management (online option available)
- Governors State University in Nursing (online)
- Lewis University in Criminal Justice, Computer Science and an Enhanced 2+2 program in Education
- National Louis University in Human Services
- Roosevelt University in Hospitality and Tourism Management

- Step 3:** Meet with a College of DuPage counselor or advisor to discuss an educational plan and answer any questions. Please call (630) 942-2259 to schedule an appointment, which are available on our main campus and at our four COD Centers in Addison, Carol Stream, Naperville and Westmont.

- Step 4:** Complete a 3+1 transfer application and submit it to the Counseling, Advising and Transfer office located in the Student Services Center (SSC), Room 3200, or email it to [3plus1@cod.edu](mailto:3plus1@cod.edu). This is NOT an official application to the school. [cod.edu/3plus1](http://cod.edu/3plus1) and select 3+1 Transfer Application

- Step 5:** Begin coursework. Depending on the 3+1 agreement, you will work toward an Associate in Arts (AA) or an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree.

- Step 6:** Meet with a College of DuPage counselor or advisor each semester to track progress and develop semester plans.

- Step 7:** Submit an official admissions application to the partner university three-to-six months before you finish your second year of College of DuPage coursework. Health science students need to be accepted into the College of DuPage Health program before applying for a 3+1 program.

- Step 8:** Once accepted into the partner university, meet with an advisor at the partner school.

- Step 9:** Meet with a COD counselor prior to registration for third-year COD coursework. This is commonly referred to as "additional coursework." If applying for financial aid, do not register for third-year coursework until you have been accepted by the partner university so financial aid is covered by the consortium agreement.

- Step 10:** Continue and complete coursework until graduation.
