We thank you for choosing the College of DuPage-Roosevelt University 3+1 Hospitality and Tourism Management program.

We would like to provide you some updates on changes in the program that will take effect in fall, 2017.

We have added Travel and Tourism Management as well as Baking and Pastry AAS degrees to the 3+1 program, a great opportunity for students in these degree tracks to also enjoy the benefits of the 3+1 option: access, affordability, and academic quality.

In addition, tuition for the 3+1 program has been fixed at a 30% discount off of the Roosevelt part-time tuition rate for the “+1” part of the program.

Furthermore, we have made a very difficult decision to move the “+1” part of the program to Roosevelt’s Schaumburg campus. We did this to both sustain the quality of the program and to consolidate resources for students. We are aware that this may pose an inconvenience and a challenge for some students. We stand ready to assist affected students to make the transition to Roosevelt’s Schaumburg campus as smooth as possible. We are confident that students will be able to complete your Roosevelt degree on schedule.
