Students answering “yes” to at least one of the questions below are eligible to take any courses that require reading and writing proficiency.

- Do you have a 2.6 cumulative non-weighted high school GPA on a 4.0 scale?
- Do you have an ACT composite score of 20 or an SAT total score of 950 or higher?
- Do you have a TOEFL score of 550 paper/pencil, 213 computer-based or 79 Internet-based or an IELTS score of 6.5 or higher?
- Do you have a Category 1 Reading and Writing score on the ACCUPLACER exam?
- Do you have College-level credit totaling 12 semester hours with at least a “C” average? (for Reading placement only)

If you answered “NO” to ALL of the questions, you need to complete our guided self-placement to determine your readiness for college-level reading and writing.
